A: Door inside lobby is locked and equipped with ballistic bulletproof glass.

Q: Do we check bags of visitors?

A: We do not, but we conduct drills each month such as, fire, intruder, etc.

Q: What is the procedure for bullying problems on busses? How are bullying problems handled?

A: Intervention Specialist, Mr. Clinkscales, talks to both the student and family to try to solve the issues. In addition, there are cameras on all busses. It is important to know who is doing the bullying so the individual can be addressed directly.

Q: Is there assigned seating?

A: There is on some buses, but the bus driver makes the decision.

Q.: Is it possible to assign a "buddy" to the student having problems?

A.: Yes. The Intervention Specialist is considering this strategy.
