- 6.1 Required under Title 1. Each year there are minor changes made at the Department of Education level then applied to the charter schools.
- 8.8 Change in law. Most noticeable change, now referred to as English learners instead of English as second language
- 9.49 Law changed in late 2016 to cut off enrollment after December 15 for K-5; September 30 for grades 6-8. Waiting list is null and void after these dates. Parents need to be notified that the wait list only applies up to a certain date. Board requests policy be amended to show this.
